PURPOSE

To establish the Dental Subcontractor policy for billing Other Preventive Services (as specified in the Current Dental Terminology (CDT) code book published by the American Dental Association (ADA)).

POLICY

The Dental Care Organization (Dental Subcontractor) requires providers to bill “Other Preventive Services” as outlined in the ADA’s CDT code book when provided to enrollees. When billing these services to the Dental Subcontractor, the provider shall also ensure such services are documented in the enrollee’s chart.

Other Preventive Services Include:

- D1310 Nutritional counseling for control of dental disease
- D1320 Tobacco counseling for the control and prevention of oral disease
- D1321 Counseling for the control and prevention of adverse oral, behavioral, and systemic health effects associated with high-risk substance use
- D1330 Oral Hygiene Instructions
- D1351 Sealant – per tooth
- D1353 Sealant repair – per tooth
- D1352 Preventive resin restoration in a moderate to high caries risk patient – permanent tooth
- D1354 Interim caries arresting medicament application – per tooth
- D1355 Caries preventative medicament application – per tooth

All fee-for-service providers will be paid \$0 and all sub-capitated providers will receive encounter data credit only for the following services:

- D1310 Nutritional counseling for control of dental disease
 - This needs to comply with the CDT description: “Counseling on food selection and dietary habits as part of treatment and control of periodontal disease and caries”; it should be an active engagement with the patient and it should be specific to the patient’s caries and/or periodontal risk status.
- D1320 Tobacco counseling for the control and prevention of oral disease
- D1330 Oral Hygiene Instructions
